Castle Carr Estate, Wainstalls, Halifax, West Yorkshire HX2 7TN Best access from South is via Junction 24 off M62, follow A629 to Halifax. Watch for the left turn sp Pellon onto Pellon Lane or turn left at roundabout on A58 then take the slip road (immediately after the roundabout) and turn right at the top on Pellon Lane. Course: 3 laps of 15 sections all on Private land set out with the **Premier** route set with the better rider in mind with easier routes in sections for **Clubman Classes** and an **Intermediate class** 50/50 route where 7 or 8 sections will be marked to be ridden on the Premier route. Intermediate rider's numbers will be on a RED background.

NO RIDING ON THE GRASS BANKINGS AROUND THE PARKING AREA.

Awards:

- Best performance on the Premier Route -THE CLUB CAPTAIN'S SHIELD
- Best performance on the Intermediate Route A trophy to be decided
- Best performance on the Clubman Route THE NEIL ANDERTON TROPHY

Awards will also be presented for best performance in each class donated by the club at the annual dinner. Ties will be decided in favour of the older rider.

Riding numbers, Letters and Programmes for the event will be handed out when you have signed on.

When you receive confirmation that your entry has been accepted, Please Pay Your £25 fee by Bank Transfer only before 6pm on Friday the 31st May unless informed otherwise. (NO cash or cheques will be accepted)

Class 5 - Bikes 345cc and over

Class 6 – Bikes under 345cc

Class 7 - Historic Bikes of ANY cc

NO GENTLE ROUTE at this venue

Riders start in groups at their allotted section but can continue at their own speed after their first section if they wish.

Entry fees will only be refunded if event is cancelled.

When you go to the manned desk to sign on, a Copy of the AMCA Acknowledgement of Risks of Motor Sport and Medical Section will be there for you to read. When you sign on you will be declaring you have had the chance to read that document.

Remember most of our venues can be seen from roads and public footpaths so be in no doubt you will be in the public eye; give the wrong impression and our sport could suffer.
