 (Formerly the West Riding Trial)
Sunday 10th July 2022



Round 4 of the Northern British Bike Championship

A classic trial for machines of pre-65 British manufacture using minor roads and tracks in the pre1965 style.

CLASSES: 1. Telefork Rigid 2. Pre-Unit Clubman 3. Clubman (All of the above ride eased routes)
 4. Pre-Unit Expert 5. Unit Expert 6. Two Stroke Expert (All of the above ride the hard route)

ELIGIBILITY: Frames, motors, gearboxes, carburettors, hubs and forks shall be of British manufacture, unless otherwise fitted by the manufacturer and have been on general sale to the public before 31 December 1964 for all pre-unit classes before 31 December 1969 for the unit and two stroke classes and before 31 December 1957 for Class 3. There is no eligibility limit for specials. Replica or pattern parts must be physically identical to the original component, except for use in the special class.

RIDERS: It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that your bike, helmet and clothing conform to the Road Traffic Act.

AWARDS: 1st Place to 10th Place in each class will receive points towards the Northern British Bike Championship.

OFFICIALS: Clerks of Course Gary Marshall and Graham Wilkinson

ENTRIES: **ONLINE ENTRIES ONLY** The event is open to eligible 'Pre65' solo machines of British manufacture. Entries will be accepted up to 5th July 2022.

Entry fee £25 (which includes Personal Accident and off-road insurance).
 Entry fee must be paid in advance upon receipt your confirmation of entry email.
 Your payment confirms acceptance to AMCA terms.

START: 10.30 am at The New Quarry House, Bingley Rd, Lees Moor, Keighley BD21 5QE (formerly the 3 Acres) 'What three words' location <https://w3w.co/nobody.drive.gently> sign posted from Cross Roads roundabout on the A629 Halifax Road.

COURSE: One lap of approx 30 miles, with around 30 sections comprising of 2 routes to be ridden by all competitors. Riders will start and finish their attempt when the front wheel spindle passes the start and ends markers. Marking will be 0, 1, 2, 3, 5. Failure is deemed to have occurred when the front wheel ceases forward motion.

Route details and supplementary regulations will be issued with rider's confirmation.

- Before taking part in the event I will read and be bound by and comply with general regulations, any supplemental and final instructions issued by the AMCA, the organisers and the circuit owners and the regulatory body.
- I will not participate whilst under the influence of alcohol or intoxicating drugs and that if I am taking any prescribed medication. I will inform the event organiser and seek approval to participate before taking part.
- If under the age of 18, my parent/guardian has read the above and will sign the declaration and agreement at the start.
