If you are paying for any other riders as well as yourself then please put all names in the reference box.

If you are not the account holder please ask the account holder to put your name in the reference box.

Premier Route (black letters on white)

Class 1 – Bikes 345cc and over

Class 2 – Bikes under 345cc

Intermediate (50/50) Route (white numbers on red)

Class 3 - Bikes 345cc and over

Class 4 – Bikes under 345cc

Clubman Route (black numbers on white)

Class 5 – Bikes 345cc and over

Class 6 – Bikes under 345cc

Class 7 – Historic Bikes of ANY cc

Gentle Route (white numbers on green)

Class 8 – Bikes of ANY cc

Riders start in groups at their allotted section but can continue at their own speed after their first section if they wish.

Entry fees will only be refunded if event is cancelled.

When you go to the manned desk to sign on, a Copy of the AMCA Acknowledgement of Risks of Motor Sport and Medical Section will be there for you to read. When you sign on you will be declaring you have had the chance to read that document.

Remember most of our venues can be seen from roads and public footpaths so be in no doubt you will be in the public eye; give the wrong impression and our sport could suffer.
